Miguel Armenta Sr, a loving father, grandfather, and great grandfather, went to be with the Lord on August 4, 2025 at the age of 69.

Miguel loved to help neighbors, friends, and family with thousands of home repairs & projects over the years because he had a big heart & enjoyed helping people out. In his free time, you could always find Miguel laughing and joking being the center star of any gathering or watching his favorite scary movies or hysterically laughing at cartoons.
